- Routing service on OpenStreetMap data
- Supports pedestrian, cyclist and car routing

### OSRM: Open Source Routing Machine

### Strengths:

- Very fast even for long routes
- Can handle many requests

#### Weaknesses:

- no customization possible (like avoid gravel roads, or prefer less busy roads)
- no height data
